*if you drop it off at English Gardens, please contact us to give us an estimate of the weight so we can record it for your specific garden, otherwise it will be combined with other donations. It will still go to people in need, it just won't be counted in your congregation's total at the end of the season.*

### **Helpful reminders:**

Harvest produce on time, don't let it get too big.

- ✓ Deliver to Food Gatherers in a timely fashion.  
*There may be a delay between when it is received, when it is distributed, and when it is used by the recipient, and unnecessary delays may make it unusable.*
- ✓ Store produce appropriately between harvesting and delivery.  
*Produce left unprotected in a vehicle will quickly begin to break down and lose vitality and nutrients. Consider keeping a cooler in your car. Plan your delivery to occur shortly after harvesting.*
- ✓ Coordinate delivery with home gardeners in your congregation.  
*Perhaps someone works or lives near the warehouse and could be a regular drop-off volunteer.*
